SUSP-14, CV Joint Boot Check

Introduction

The CV Joint boots should be inspected every 15,000 miles.

Tools

- Jack Stands
- Floor Jack

Procedure

- 1. Raise the rear of the vehicle on jack stands.
- 2. Inspect the CV Joint Boots for signs of cracking.
- 3. Squeeze the CV Joint Boots and inspect for signs of grease leaking from the boot.
- 4. If the boot shows signs of deep cracking (i.e. more than 1 mm) **OR** if there is any leakage from cracks in the boot, it should be replaced.
